PATIENT DUTIES

Anyone who goes to a Hospital Center demanding Medical Care has to know the rights that protect them at the time of applying for such care.

HOSPITAL POVISA, Anonymous Society, in compliance with Law 14/86 General of Health, Galician Law 3/2001 on Informed Consent and Medical History, as well Law 3/2005 which amends the above said, State Law 41/2002 on Informed Consent and Medical Records and Health Law 8/2008 of Galicia, and Regulation 2016/679, of April 27, General of Data Protection, informs you about the rights and duties of patients who come to this Hospital, which are recorded in the provisions cited below.

PATIENT DUTIES

1 To Take care of the facilities and help maintain the habitability of Health Institutions.

2 Be responsible for the proper use of services provided by the health system.

3 To record, if so is the case, in writing, their refusal to a treatment proposed by the Hospital, as well as to sign the voluntary discharge to be submitted by the Hospital to the denial.

4 To provide information about your physical condition or health in a loyal and true way, collaborating with the medical staff in your care.

PATIENT DUTIES

5 To Accept the discharge when his care process is finished, when it has been found that the clinical situation of the patient would not improve, if his stay were longer or when the complexity of the process advised his transfer to a referral center.

6 To record in writing, if it is so, of the refusal to be informed.

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
